## Court Circular

**BALMORAL CASTLE, Aug. 14.**  
The Queen and the Duke of Edinburgh disembarked from H.M. yacht Britannia this morning in Banff Bay and, on landing at Macduff, were received by the Secretary of State for Scotland (the Rt. Hon. John MacLay, M.P.), her Majesty's Lieutenant for Banffshire (Sir George Abercromby, Bt.) and the Provost of Macduff (Mr. Robert Henry).

Her Majesty and his Royal Highness proceeded by motor-car to visit Banff, Whitehills, Portsoy, Cullen, Portnockie, Findochty and Buckie.

The Queen and the Duke of Edinburgh then visited Fochabers and were received by her Majesty's Lieutenant for Morayshire (Brig. Sir Henry Houldsworth) and the Convener (Lt.-Col. Kenneth Mackessack).

Her Majesty, with his Royal Highness, subsequently at Elgin honoured the Convener and members of the Moray County Council with her presence at luncheon in the county buildings.

This afternoon the Queen and the Duke of Edinburgh visited the Royal Air Force Station, Kinloss. Having been received by Mr. W. J. Taylor, M.P. (Parliamentary Under-Secretary of State for Air), her Majesty presented a Standard to No. 120 Squadron.

After the presentation, the Queen was graciously pleased to address the Squadron and Wing

Cmdr. H. M. Carson replied on behalf of the Squadron.

Her Majesty subsequently opened the new Officers' Mess and later, with his Royal Highness, left the Royal Air Force Station, Kinloss, to visit Forbes and Nairn, where, at the Links, the Queen and the Duke of Edinburgh were received by her Majesty's Lieutenant for Nairn (Brig. J. E. Stirling), the Convener (Earl Cawdor) and the Provost of Nairn (Mr. George Borwick).

After visiting Grantown-on-Spey (Morayshire), her Majesty and his Royal Highness drove to Balmoral Castle and were received by her Majesty's Lieutenant for Aberdeenshire (Sir Ian Forbes-Leith of Fyvie, Bt.), the Laird of Invercauld (Capt. Alwyne Farquharson) and the Provost of Ballater (Mr. William Anderson).

The Countess of Leicester, Sir Edward Ford, Mr. William Heseltine and Sqdn. Ldr. Henton Carver were in attendance.

Miss Mary Morrison has succeeded the Countess of Leicester as Lady in Waiting to the Queen.
